A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

Forty days after Easter (May 9th) we celebrate Ascension Day which is recorded in Acts 1:6-11; Eugene Peterson's, The Message, translates the passage this way: ⁶When they were together for the last time they asked, "Master, are you going to restore the kingdom to Israel now? Is this the time?" ⁷⁻⁸He told them, "You don't get to know the time. Timing is the Father's business. What you'll get is the Holy Spirit. And when the Holy Spirit comes on you, you will be able to be my witnesses in Jerusalem, all over Judea and Samaria, even to the ends of the world." ⁹⁻¹¹ These were his last words. As they watched, he was taken up and disappeared in a cloud. They stood there, staring into the empty sky. Suddenly two men appeared—in white robes! They said, "You Galileans!—why do you just stand here looking up at an empty sky? This very Jesus who was taken up from among you to heaven will come as certainly—and mysteriously—as he left."

Yes, Jesus's physical presence then and now is gone from our sight – but God did not leave us alone! "What you'll get is the Holy Spirit," Jesus said, ".....you will be able to be my witnesses....even to the ends of the world."

When the Feast of Pentecost came, they were all together in one place (Acts 2:1). Yes, the day of Pentecost came (the 50th day after Easter – "Pentecost" means 50th)* - and so did the blessing of the coming of the Holy Spirit – just as Jesus promised – a kind of "Heavenly Helper" – a "Counselor" – a "Comforter" - teaching us, leading us, inspiring us, encouraging us. In the guide to understanding & celebrating the Christian church year, Arden Mead and King Schoenfeld state: "Some people say that the second chapter of the book of The Acts of the Apostles ('apostle' means someone who is sent to do something) should really be "The Acts of the Holy Spirit" because the Spirit is the one who moves the apostles to do what they do in the name of Jesus and works through them to accomplish wonderful things."

I hope that on the Day of Pentecost this year, May 19th, the Holy Spirit moves you to gather together in one place – that one place being at St. Paul's United Church of Christ at 10:15am – to celebrate Pentecost! May 19th will also be our Celebration Sunday traditional service – where we honor graduates, the Jim Frantz Award recipient, and leaders of our Christian Education ministries – a time of celebrating what has been done by the movement of the Holy Spirit!

May the Holy Spirit continue to move in the lives of God's people everywhere! And may we at St. Paul's United Church of Christ be moved by the Holy Spirit to do what we do in the name of Jesus and may the Holy Spirit work through us to accomplish wonderful things!

Blessings to you in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit!

^{*(}The Jewish festival of Pentecost, 50 days after Passover, was observed by the first Christians, including St. Paul; see Acts 20:16. Most Christians have since tied their Pentecost to the date of Easter.)

CONFIRMATION CLASS OF 2025


Confirmation classes are open to our young people in 6th through 12th grades that are ready to enter this time of faith formation. In the United Church of Christ, when an infant or young child is baptized, one or both parents and/or one or more sponsors promises to assume certain responsibilities for the Christian nurture of the baptized. The entire congregation also assumes the role of sponsors as its members promise to provide a supportive Christian community in which a child may grow in awareness and understanding concerning the meaning of life in Christ. At the end of the faith formation sessions (May 2025) – each confirmand decides if they are ready to make public agreement to the baptismal promises previously made by their parent(s).

Email me at pastortrudy@stpaulsucc.net if your son or daughter will be joining the confirmation class of 2025. A full registration form will be made available to you when your email is received. The primary resource used in our faith formation sessions is *Making Disciples*, which is a mentor-based resource. Mentors are required to have a background check on file with the church office. Instead of using an existing list of mentors, your son/daughter is encouraged to select a mentor that is not a relative. Your son/daughter must make this request of an active member of the congregation. If the person agrees to mentor your son/daughter, I will need to confirm that there is a background check on file in the church office for that individual.


Mentors will be required to attend some of our group sessions and also to periodically and individually meet in-person with the confirmation candidate. There must always be a second adult present with me when I lead any of the sessions. Not all sessions will be held at the church. I have contacted FISH about meeting at the FISH location in the Fall; this gathering would include a service project while we are at their location. We will also be holding a session at Camp Men-O-Lan and be participating in outdoor activities – connecting with God's creation.

An in-person "Welcome" and information gathering will be held in July for all participants (candidates, parents, and mentors) to review confirmation requirements. All participants must attend this gathering to begin the confirmation journey in September.

Making Disciples is a 13-session mentorbased confirmation program that pairs confirmands with adult mentors and guides them through a variety of learning experiences that will strengthen the student's understanding of the faith while connecting him or her with the community of believers in a personal way.


