JAMES FRANTZ DEDICATION AWARD

On Celebration Sunday this award will be given to a young person between the ages of 13 and 19 who exemplifies dedication to the church, similar to that which was shown by the late Jim Frantz. Jim was a lifelong member of St. Paul's from 1919 through 1999. Last year's award recipient was Simon Ziegenfuss.

Nominees should show dedication to the life of the church in such ways as volunteering at church activities, church event and worship attendance, etc.

The award will be a monetary gift from a CD we have invested and will be donated to a charity of the recipient's choice in his/her name. The recipient's name will be placed on the James Frantz Dedication Award plague located in Fretz Hall.

Thank you to everyone who donated to Pennridge FISH with the Easter/Passover donations and other items. We donated 123.8lbs of supplies in April. GREAT JOB! A big thank you from Pennridge FISH too.

Here is some information about FISH. For 40 years, FISH was run entirely by volunteers! In 2011, they hired their very first part-time employee. Today, they have one full-time director, a part-time building manager, and about 70 regular volunteers who make the magic happen. They are always looking for volunteers. FISH is currently serving 1,540 individuals in their free choice food pantry and around 100 families a month in their free clothing and houseware outlet.

For the month of May, I would like to "spice up" the FISH supplies with donations of spices, condiments, and cooking oil. Paige, the director at FISH says they don't get a lot of spices so please help us to "spice it up!" Of course, any donation is greatly appreciated. Thank you!


